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NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

Notice is hereby given that on 11 June 2026, Prime Solar Solutions Corp. (Prime Solar) filed a *Petition for Dispute Resolution* dated 08 May 2026 (Petition) against Manila Electric Company (MERALCO), relative to the alleged dispute arising from the determination of the fair market value of the subject point-to-point assets/facilities in the Commission’s *Order* dated 10 April 2026 in ERC Case No. 2020-003 MC¹.

The docketed copy of the *Petition*, excluding its annexes, is attached as Annex “A” of the *Notice of Virtual Hearing*.

Finding the *Petition* to be sufficient in form and with the required fees having been paid, the Commission hereby sets the same for hearing pursuant to the pertinent rules of the Commission, as follows:

Any interested stakeholder may submit its comments and/or clarifications at least **one (1) calendar day** prior to the scheduled initial virtual hearing, via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph. The Commission shall give priority to the stakeholders who have duly submitted their respective comments and/or clarifications, to discuss the same and propound questions during the course of the expository presentation.

Moreover, all persons who have an interest in the subject matter of the instant case may become a party by filing with the Commission via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, and copy furnishing the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, a verified Petition to Intervene at least **five (5) calendar days** prior to the date of the initial virtual hearing. The verified Petition to Intervene must follow the requirements under Rule 9 of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure, indicating therein the docket number and title of the case, and state the following:

- 1) The petitioner's name, mailing address, and e-mail address;
- 2) The nature of petitioner's interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and the way and manner in which such interest is affected by the issues involved in the proceeding; and
- 3) A statement of the relief desired.

All interested parties filing their Petition to Intervene, Opposition or Comment are required to submit the hard copies thereof through personal service, registered mail or ordinary mail/private courier, **within five (5) working days** from the date that the same were electronically submitted, as reflected in the acknowledgement receipt e-mail sent by the Commission.

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Any of the persons mentioned in the preceding paragraphs may access the copy of the *Petition* through the Commission's official website at www.erc.gov.ph.

Finally, all interested persons may be allowed to join the scheduled virtual hearings by providing the Commission, through legal.virtualhearings@erc.ph, their respective e-mail addresses, indicating therein the case number of the instant *Petition*. The Commission will send the access link/s to the aforementioned hearing platform within five (5) working days prior to the scheduled hearings.
