NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

Notice is hereby given that on 04 June 2026, the Prime Solar Solutions Corp. (Prime Solar) filed a *Petition for Dispute Resolution* dated 08 May 2026, against the Manila Electric Company (MERALCO), relative to the Commission’s Order dated 10 April 2026¹ in ERC Case No. 2019-032 MC, entitled “In the Matter of the Application for Authority to Develop and Own Dedicated Point-to-Point Limited Transmission Facilities to Connect the Tanauan Solar Power Plant to the MERALCO CIP 2 Substation with Prayer for Confidential Treatment of Information” (the “Point-to-Point Application”). In the said Order, the Honorable Commission ruled, among others, that the approval of the fair market price for the facilities required for competitive purposes and/or transferred to and to be paid by MERALCO shall be resolved through a dispute resolution case.²

Any interested stakeholder may submit its comments and/or clarifications at least **one (1) calendar day** prior to the scheduled initial virtual hearing, via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph. The Commission shall give priority to the stakeholders who have duly submitted their respective comments and/or clarifications, to discuss the same and propound questions during the course of the expository presentation.

Moreover, all persons who have an interest in the subject matter of the instant case may become a party by filing with the Commission via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, and copy furnishing the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, a verified *Petition to Intervene* at least **five (5) calendar days** prior to the date of the initial virtual hearing. The verified *Petition to Intervene* must follow the requirements under Rule 9 of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure, indicating therein the docket number and title of the case, and state the following:

- 1) The petitioner’s name, mailing address, and e-mail address;
- 2) The nature of petitioner’s interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and the way and manner in which such interest is affected by the issues involved in the proceeding; and
- 3) A statement of the relief desired.

Any of the persons mentioned in the preceding paragraphs may access the copy of the *Petition* through the Commission's official website at www.erc.gov.ph.
